MARK THE DATE!

October 29th was World Stroke Day! It's a special day to raise awareness worldwide and take action on stroke.



BUSTING MYTHS ABOUT STROKE

Myth #1: Stroke affects the heart.

<u>FACT:</u> Stroke affects the **brain**, not the heart. It occurs when **blood flow** in the brain is **interrupted**, causing damage.

Myth #2: Stroke symptoms that are temporary can be ignored.

<u>FACT:</u> Temporary stroke symptoms indicate a "mini-stroke". These are important warning signs for an actual stroke.

Myth #3: Recovering from a stroke happens quickly.

<u>FACT:</u> It can take **years to a lifetime** for someone to recover from a stroke!

HOW TO RECOGNIZE SIGNS OF A STROKE

A stroke is a life-threatening condition.

It is important to be able to recognize the signs of stroke, as it can save someone's life.

Face is it drooping?

Arms can you raise both?

Speech is it slurred or jumbled?

Time to call 9-1-1 right away.

Act **FAST**. Lifesaving treatment begins the second you call 9-1-1.

- 2) My stroke happened **out of nowhere**. I was telling a joke when out with my friends and no one laughed. I think it was because my speech was slurring. I want to **educate people about the signs of stroke** (F.A.S.T), **aphasia** and **recovery**.
- 3) I started doing lots of Zooms over COVID so I thought it was a good time to start (I use zoom to record my videos).

- I am proud to share my own story and reach out to other young stroke survivors

- Sometimes I re-watch the videos and I feel it's not as good as I want it, but you just keep going!






The C.H.A.T candy machine has a new home thanks to Dr. Kathleen Jones of Professional Audiology Hys Centre.
